Château Tour de Boisset

AOC Bordeaux Supérieur

LOCATION

The vineyard is situated on the slopes of the Entre-Deux-Mers plateau, 10 km south of Saint Emilion, and surrounded by ruins of the 12th century Boisset chapel.

Marc Lurton, oenologist and graduate of the University of Bordeaux, manages the estate with his wife Agnès.

GRAPE VARIETIES

50% Merlot - 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

TERROIR

Clay-limestone. Asteriated limestone subsoil.

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

The grapes are grown in an Agrocert-certified organic vineyard.

FERMENTATION AND AGEING

The quality of the red wine grapes is the result of meticulous work in the vineyard. The grapes are sorted rigorously during picking (different varieties and from different plots are fermented separately). Traditional Bordeaux winemaking: destemming and fermentation between 25 and 30°C. Maceration lasts 3-4 weeks to obtain greater complexity followed by malolactic fermentation.

Twenty percent of the blend is aged in oak barrels in underground cellars (a former quarry) located underneath the château vineyards.

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby-red colour with powerful red fruit aromas.

Elegant on the palate with ripe, silky tannin.

A complex wine with a marked minerality due to vine roots that sink deep into the limestone rock terroir.

Serve at 16-18°C
